*The community check is determined by the monthly budget of a particular community household, covering rent, board, and utilities, and divided among the number of volunteers in the community (usually 4-8).

*Insurance costs are determined by an agency's insurance provider. All medical costs are incurred by the agency, including co-pays. Dental coverage, optical coverage, and prescriptions for pre-existing conditions are optional.

*Agencies are responsible for paying the travel costs of their volunteer. Costs include travel from Orientation near Portland, OR to their placement locale, daily work transportation (e.g. bus pass or bicycle), and travel by the most economical mode reasonable to their home or next destination at the end of the year.

*Average annual costs vary greatly depending upon locale and the agency's expenses.

General Placement Process Timeline

Late September

Agency Applications for a Jesuit Volunteer (JV) become available online.

December 15, 2009

Agency Applications for a JV due to JVC Northwest. Only online applications will be accepted.

Late January, 2010

Agencies notified by mail of acceptance status.

March 1

JVC Northwest begins interviewing potential Jesuit Volunteers and matching them with partnering agencies.

March-July

Agencies conduct interviews with potential JVs within two weeks of receiving application packet from JVC Northwest. As JVs fill accepted positions, alternate positions may be opened.

Late July

JVC Northwest will send Placement Agreement with monthly payment schedule to agencies once the size of each household is determined.

Early August

Orientation for all Northwest JVs near Portland, OR. After Orientation, JVs travel to their service communities and have a brief local orientation before beginning work in mid-August.
