General Placement Process Timeline

Fall, 2011

Agency applications for a JV/AmeriCorps Member become available online.

December 1, 2011

Agency applications for a JV/AmeriCorps Member due to JVC Northwest. Only online applications will be accepted.

January, 2012

Agencies notified by mail of acceptance status.

Late February, 2012

JVC Northwest begins interviewing potential JV/AmeriCorps Members and matching them with partnering agencies.

March-July, 2012

Agencies conduct interviews with potential JV/AmeriCorps Members within seven working days of receiving application packet from JVC Northwest. As JV/AmeriCorps Members fill accepted positions, alternate positions may be opened.

July, 2012

JVC Northwest will send a Placement Agreement: the contract between JVC Northwest, the JV/AmeriCorps Member, and the partner agency.

August 6 - 11, 2012

Orientation for all JV/AmeriCorps Members near Portland, OR. After Orientation, volunteers travel to their service communities and have a brief local orientation before beginning their year of service.

August 15, 2012

First day of service for all JV/AmeriCorps Members.

AMERICORPS

In 2010, JVC Northwest became an AmeriCorps National Direct Grantee. With the exception of a small number of placements where the majority of the Jesuit Volunteer's service is in advocacy or ministry, Jesuit Volunteers enroll in AmeriCorps and are eligible to receive an Education Award to put toward school loans or future education after satisfactorily completing their terms of service. Some of the key requirements of a JVC Northwest AmeriCorps placement are:

- Provide a position that enhances an agency's services without displacing an employee or volunteer
- Assign an AmeriCorps site supervisor who participates in the JVC Northwest AmeriCorps Program Orientation (via conference call) and who abides by the responsibilities outlined in the site supervisor manual, including but not limited to:
 - Provide orientation for the JV/AmeriCorps Member
 - Provide a mid-term and end-of-year evaluation
 - Approve the JV/AmeriCorps Member's monthly time logs
 - Attend one local meeting of AmeriCorps site supervisors during Area Director's fall visit
- Allow JV/AmeriCorps Members to attend AmeriCorps sponsored events such as Make a Difference Day, MLK Service Day
- Display an AmeriCorps sign at the service site
- Assist the JV/AmeriCorps Member in submitting data to JVC Northwest to prove the impact of the service of the JV/AmeriCorps Member
